- Monitor student behavior and ensure it is respectful, responsible, and safe

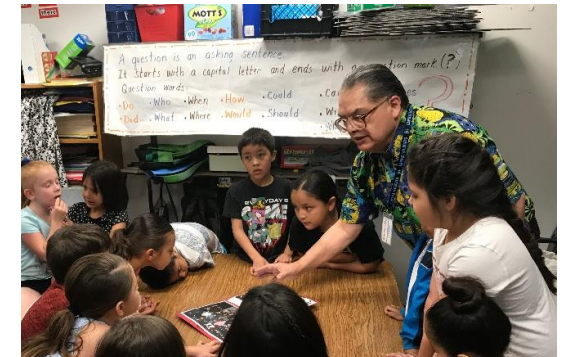
Student Responsibilities
