Policy Title: VACANCIES ON BOARD

A vacancy shall be declared by the Board of Trustees when any nominee has been elected but has failed to qualify for office or within thirty (30) days of when any trustee shall: a) die; b) resign as trustee; c) remove him/herself from his or her zone of residence; d) no longer be a resident or school district elector of the district; e) refuse to serve as a trustee; f) without excuse acceptable to the board, fail to attend four (4) consecutive regular meetings of the Board; or (g) be recalled and be discharged from office as provided in Section 33-439, Idaho Code.

Such declaration of vacancy shall be made at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Trustees, when any of the above mentioned conditions are determined to exist.

The Board of Trustees shall appoint to such vacancy a person qualified to serve as trustee of the school district, providing there remains in membership on the board a majority of the membership; and the board shall notify the State Superintendent of Public

Instruction of the appointment. The appointment must be made within ninety (90) days of the declaration of vacancy. Otherwise, after (120) days, appointments shall be made by the Board of County Commissioners. Any person appointed as herein provided shall serve for the balance of the unexpired term of office, which was declared vacant. At such annual election, a trustee shall be elected to complete the unexpired term of the office, which was declared vacant and filled by appointment. The elected trustee shall assume office at the annual meeting of the school district next following the election period.
