Policy Title: TREASURERS

Code: 202.5

TREASURER

The treasurer elected by the Board of Trustees of a school district shall have such duties as the board may prescribe. He/she shall be placed under fidelity bond issued by a surety company authorized to do business in the state of Idaho, in such amount as the Board of Trustees may from time to time determine, or under personal bond equal to twice such determined amount with at least two (2) sureties, who each shall qualify as in the case of sureties on the boards of county officers.

The treasurer shall deposit the moneys of the district in accordance with the provisions of the Public Depository Law as now appearing or as it may be amended.

ASSISTANT TREASURER

The Board of Trustees may elect one (1) or more assistant treasurers who shall have such duties as the board may prescribe. Assistant treasurers shall be subject to the control, supervision and direction of the treasurer of the district. An assistant treasurer may perform the statutory duties prescribed by law for the treasurer to the extent authorized by the board of trustees.
