Policy Title: ANNUAL MEETINGS

Code: 203.1

The annual meeting is characterized by statute as the meeting of the school district, rather than merely of the Board of Trustees. The purpose of the annual meeting is primarily devoted to the swearing in of the newly elected, reelected or appointed trustees, election of officers, scheduling of regular meetings, designation of places for posting public notices and the conduct of regular business.

This meeting shall be on the date of its regular July meeting and no special call of the annual meeting is required.

The oath of office shall be administered at the annual meeting by the clerk or by a trustee of the district.

The board shall elect as its officers a chairman, vice-chairman, clerk and a treasurer. The clerk and the treasurer may be members of the board or, at the discretion of the board, either or both may be selected from among competent and responsible persons outside the membership of the board.

In compliance with the Idaho Code's requirement of posting public notices prior to specified events, the trustees shall at the annual meeting, designate these places. Such designation does not prevent the posting of additional notices at other than the designated places. The board shall also instruct the clerk to post public notice of the day, week, month and time when the regular meetings will be held as recommended.*
