Policy Title: REGULAR MEETINGS Code: 203.2

Regular meetings of each board of school district trustees, held to conduct the business of the district, shall be monthly, on a uniform day of a uniform week as determined at the annual meeting. Regular meetings may be canceled with a majority consent of all members. If, during the school year, the board finds it necessary to change the date a regular meeting(s) is held, the clerk shall post written notice of this change in the approved designated places.

A quorum for the transaction of business of the Board of Trustees shall consist of a majority (three). Unless provided by law, all questions shall be determined by a majority of the vote cast. The chairman of the board may vote in all cases.

The board designates the day, time and place for the regular meeting at its annual meeting in July of each year. When a regular meeting date falls on a holiday, the meeting shall be within one week, the date and hour to be determined by the board and posted.

The delivery of the meeting agenda shall constitute notice to the board members of a regular meeting.
