Policy Title: BEREAVEMENT

Code: 403.2

Professional employees shall be allowed to use bereavement leave when such absence is due to personal attendance at the funeral of a member of the employee's immediate family. For purposes of this section, immediate family is defined as any of the following: spouse, children, parents, brothers, sisters, grandparents, grandchildren, aunt, uncle, cousin, niece, nephew, mother-in-law, father-in-law, sister-in-law, brother-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, or any other relative living in the employee's domicile on a long-term, permanent basis.

Under special circumstances, on a case-by-case basis, the superintendent may allow an additional two (2) days, which days shall be deducted from sick leave. One (1) day leave per year with full pay will be allowed for a professional employee to attend a memorial service in the case of the death of a close friend or member of that friend's immediate family.
