## STUDENT PERSONNEL Series 500

Policy Title: NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS (PK-12) Code: 502.9

Students who do not live within the district shall not be denied admittance on the basis of residency. In the event the presence of the applying student would be detrimental to the health and safety of the other students; or that the applying student is not in good standing in his/her home district; or that the addition of this student would result in overcrowding in the classroom then that student may be denied admittance.

Actual student enrollment may be considered before approving an out-of-district enrollment request. As a guide, the district has established the following sizes as target numbers for year-to-year operations:

22:1 Grades K-3

25:1 Grades 4-6

26:1 Grades 7-12

Non-resident students must furnish their own transportation to the school or nearest bus stop.

The decision about assessing tuition for non-resident students will be left to the discretion of the Board of Trustees in accordance with state guidelines.

Non-resident Attendance Contract: Students must obey *all* policies and regulations of the Lapwai School District as a condition for continued attendance including:

- Exclusive of school-scheduled activities, a student must attend a minimum of 88% of the classroom scheduled days per semester.
- If the efforts detailed in policy fail to improve attendance, the principal will refer the student to the superintendent. After reviewing the student's attendance record, the superintendent may arrange a hearing before the Board of Trustees in accordance with Idaho Code 33-205, Denial of School Attendance, for habitual truancy.
