Policy Title: TEXTBOOK SELECTION AND
INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

Code: 603.4

The texts adopted by the district shall be from the textbook adoptions for Idaho public schools developed by the State Board of Education.

Materials for classrooms and libraries will be selected by the appropriate professional personnel in consultation with district administrators and building principals. The Board asserts the responsibility of the district is to:

- Provide materials that will enrich and support the curriculum, taking into consideration the varied interests, abilities and maturity levels of the students served.
- Provide materials that will stimulate growth in factual knowledge, literary appreciation, aesthetic values and ethical standards.
- Provide a background of information, which will enable students to make intelligent judgments in their daily lives.
- Provide materials on opposing sides of controversial issues so that young citizens may develop, under guidance, the practice of analytical reading and thinking.
- To provide materials representative of the many religions and ethnic and cultural groups, showing their contributions to our heritage.
