## AUXILIARY SERVICES Series 700

Policy Title: TRANSPORTATION Code: 702.1

To afford more equal opportunity for public school attendance, the Board of Trustees of each district shall, where practicable, provide transportation for the public school pupils of the district, under conditions and limitations herein set forth. In approving the routing of any school bus or other passenger equipment, or in the maintenance and operation of all such transportation equipment, or in the appointment or employment of chauffeurs, the primary requirements to be observed by the Board of Trustees are the safety and adequate protection of the health of the pupils. Nothing herein contained shall prevent any Board of Trustees from denying transportation to any pupil in any school bus or other transportation equipment operated by or under the authority of said board, upon good cause being given in writing to the parents and/or guardians of such pupil.

If bad weather causes hazardous roads, the decision to operate bus routes will be made by the superintendent (or designee) with input from the transportation supervisor (as appropriate). Since weather conditions change rapidly in our area, the individual bus driver is authorized to not run a route if he/she evaluates the situation as hazardous and a contact cannot be made with the superintendent or transportation supervisor.
