Policy Title: HEALTHY STUDENTS/SAFE SCHOOLS

Code: 703.35

The Lapwai School Board and District realize that healthy students and a safe school environment have a close inter-relationship. Available finances will certainly be a factor in determining the level at which needs can be met. Grant funding may be pursued.

It shall be the intent of the Lapwai School District to:

- Establish and maintain a safe school environment;
- Prevent, minimize and eradicate the use of alcohol/drugs and violence through comprehensive prevention programming and early intervention for children and youth at risk;
- Improve student mental health (and strive to destigmatize mental health concerns);
- Strive to optimize the emotional and psychosocial development of preschool aged children;
- Establish and maintain a strong connection between schools and communities whereby students, parents, community members and school personnel are valued for their unique expertise and invested in safe and drug free schools and communities; and
- Ensure implementation and enforcement of existing safe school policies.
