Policy Title: COMMUNITY USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

Code: 902.1

The school gymnasium, play fields, auditorium and other rooms are primarily designed for school or school-related purposes. When they do not conflict with school use, community groups may use the facilities for meetings of an educational, patriotic, philanthropic, civic, musical, recreational or social nature intended to promote the public welfare.

Usage for purely civic purposes within the community may be permitted with completion of the Facilities Rental Contract and payment of fees and damage deposit.

Political meetings shall not be permitted without specific permission of the board.

Churches and other religious organizations may be granted occasional use of the school buildings if other community facilities are not available. Application shall not be considered for a series of religious meetings. Sunday use shall be discouraged.

Insurance exclusions prohibit the use of school buses for other than school-related purposes.
