4th Grade Nez Perce Language Instruction



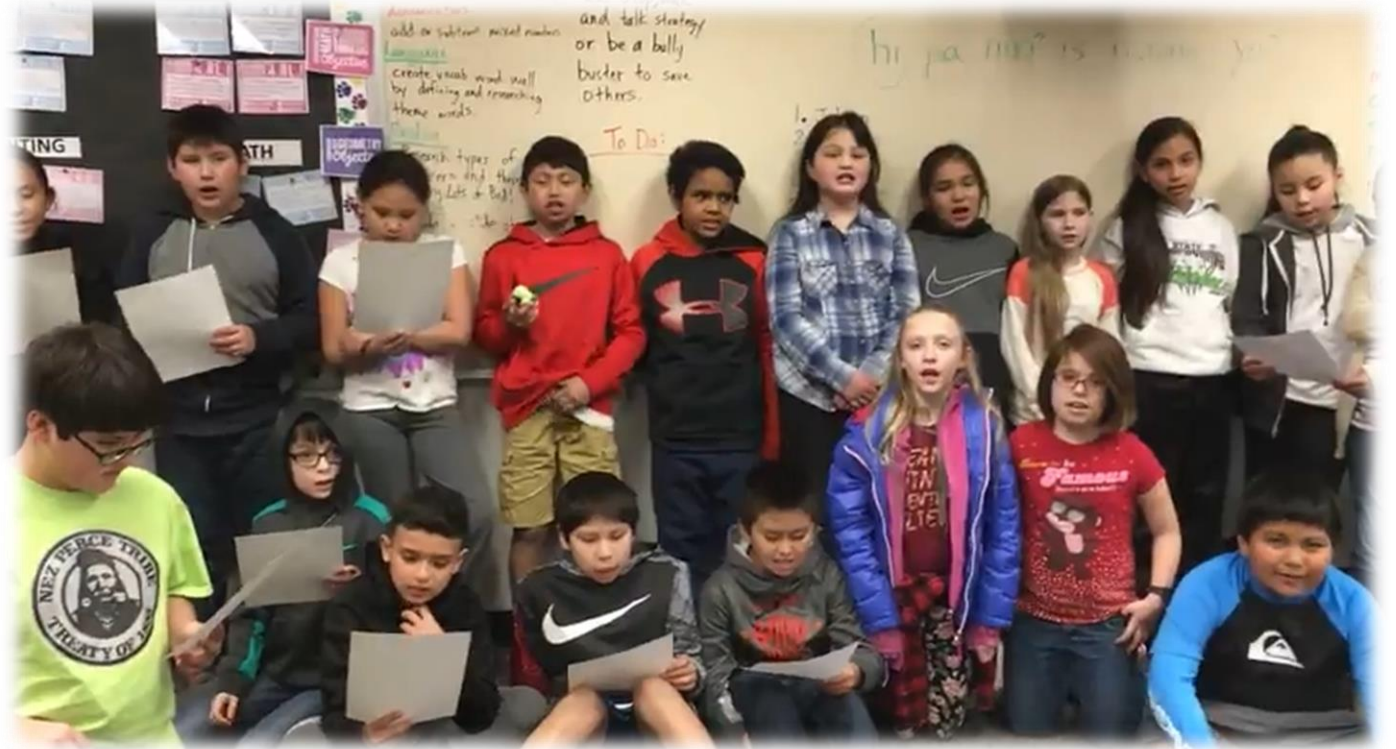
