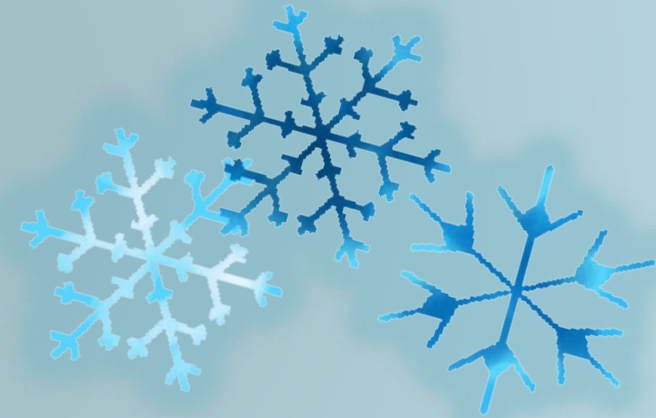
The Lapwai School District encourages a holistic approach to staff and student wellness that is sensitive to individual and community needs.

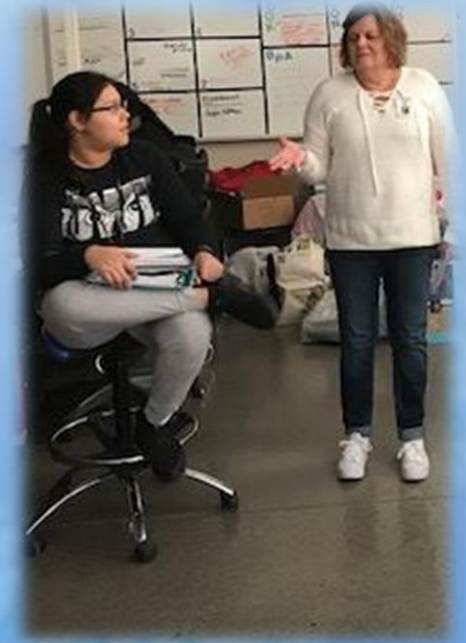
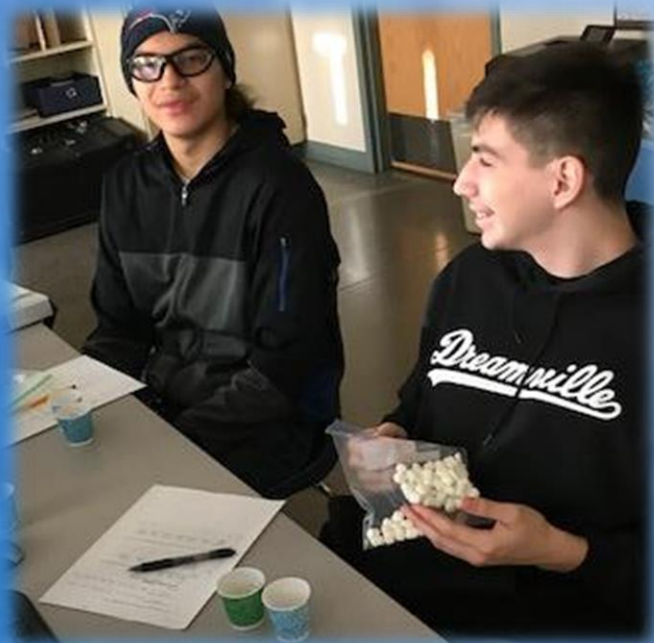


Engaging Economics

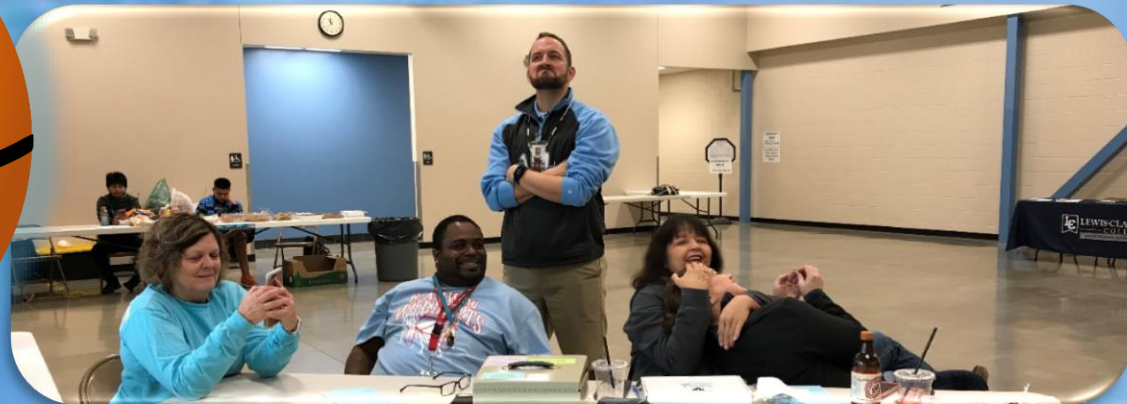

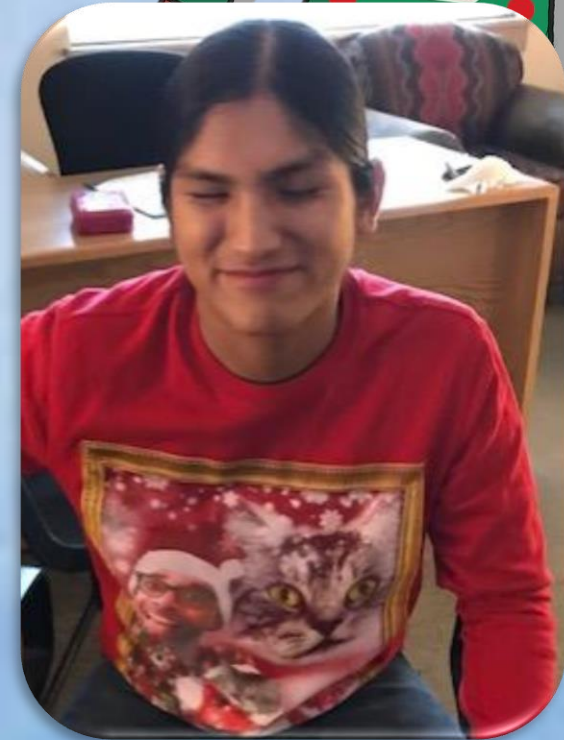
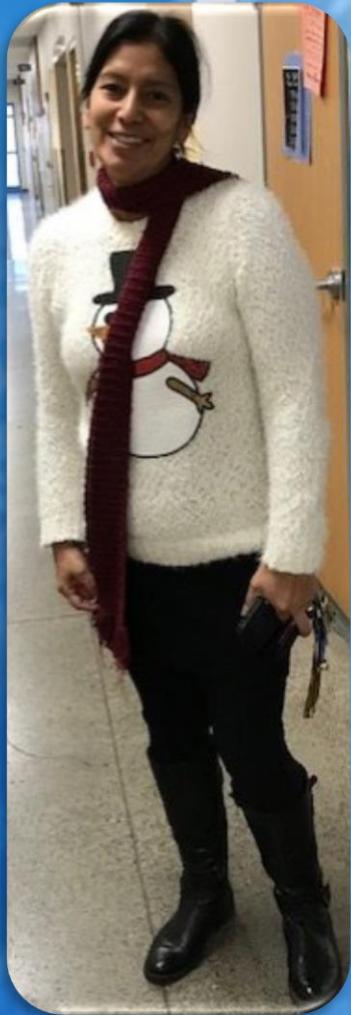
