First Semester 2017-2018

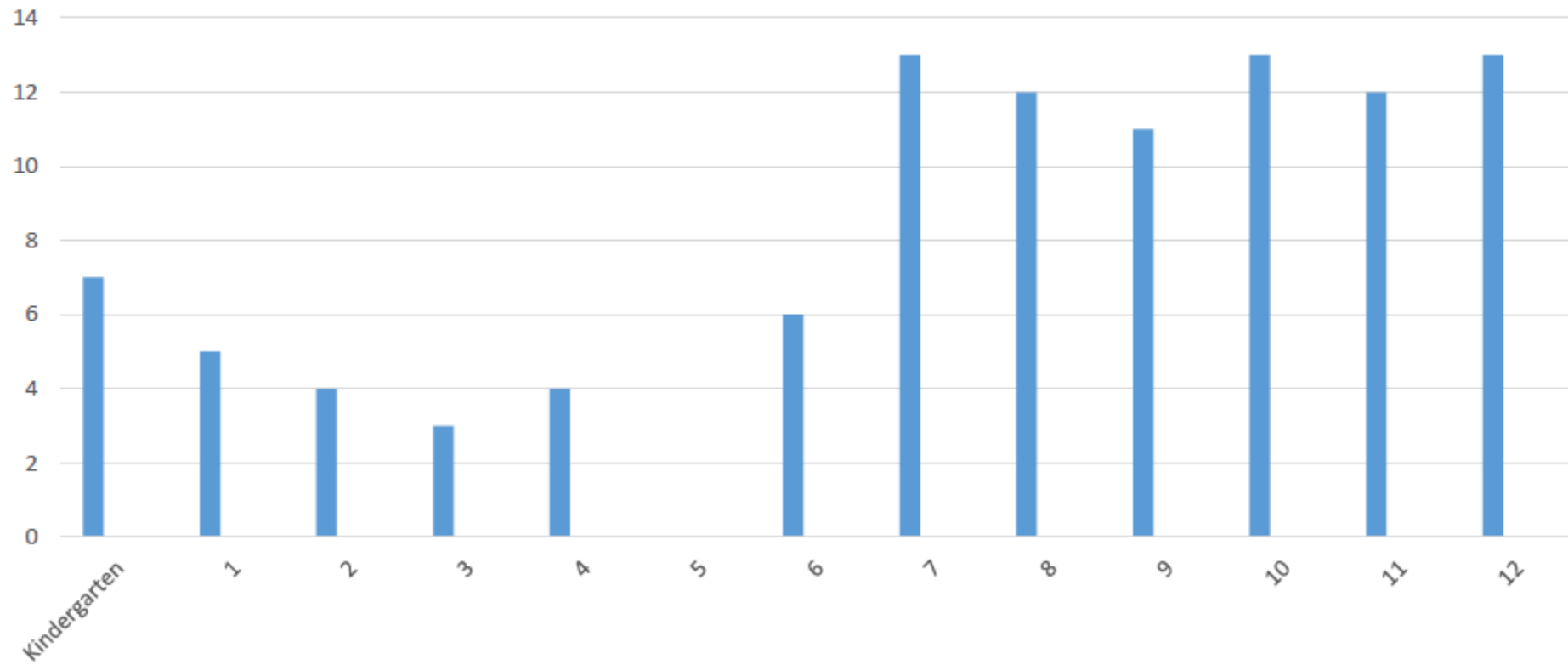
August 29, 2017 to January 11, 2018

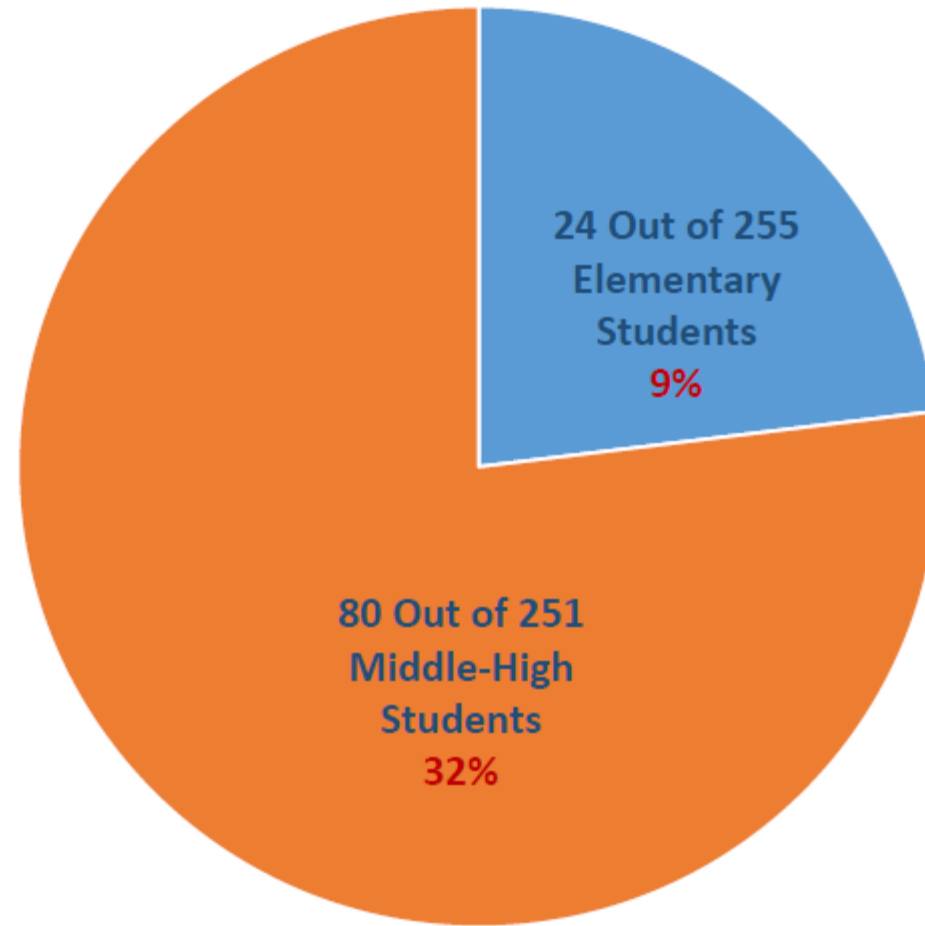

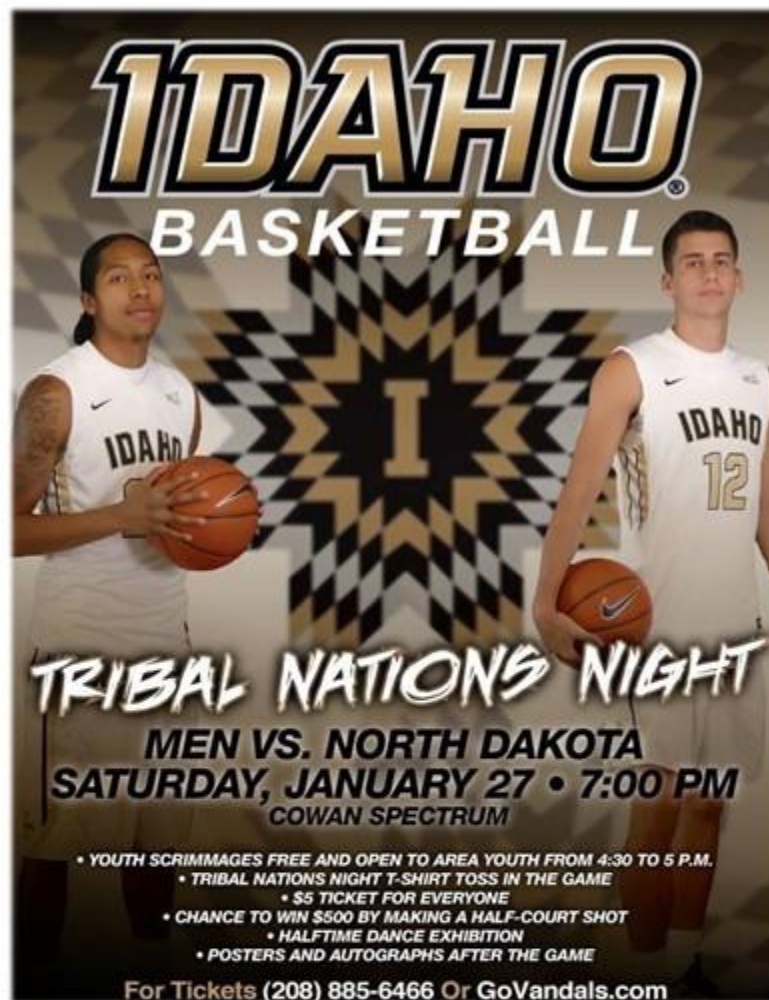
