The Lapwai Elementary School Afterschool Program was awarded a \$15,000 science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) grant to expand drone technology instruction to the elementary school. Thank you Candace Hoisington, Program Director, for your hard work on the proposal.

65 middle school students are currently taking Advanced Opportunity Droneology.

Drone use in Environmental Science is also offered to high school students through a partnership with the Nez Perce Tribe and University of Idaho.
