Academic Development Institute, and Lewis-Clark State College.


Our 2018 Summit is also coordinated with the Washington State University Tribal Liaison's Office.



White House Easter Egg Roll


On Monday, April 2, 2018, First Lady Melania Trump will host the 140th annual Easter Egg Roll on the South Lawn of the White House.
