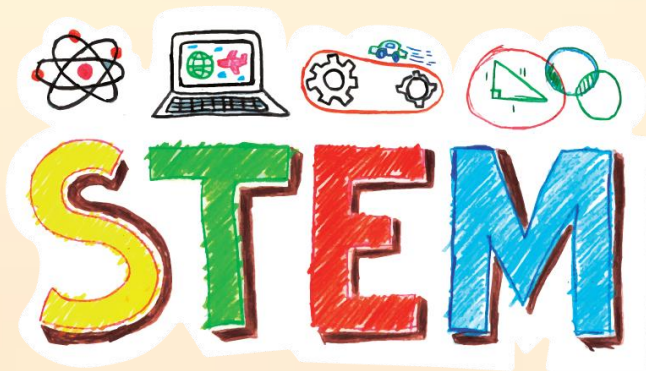

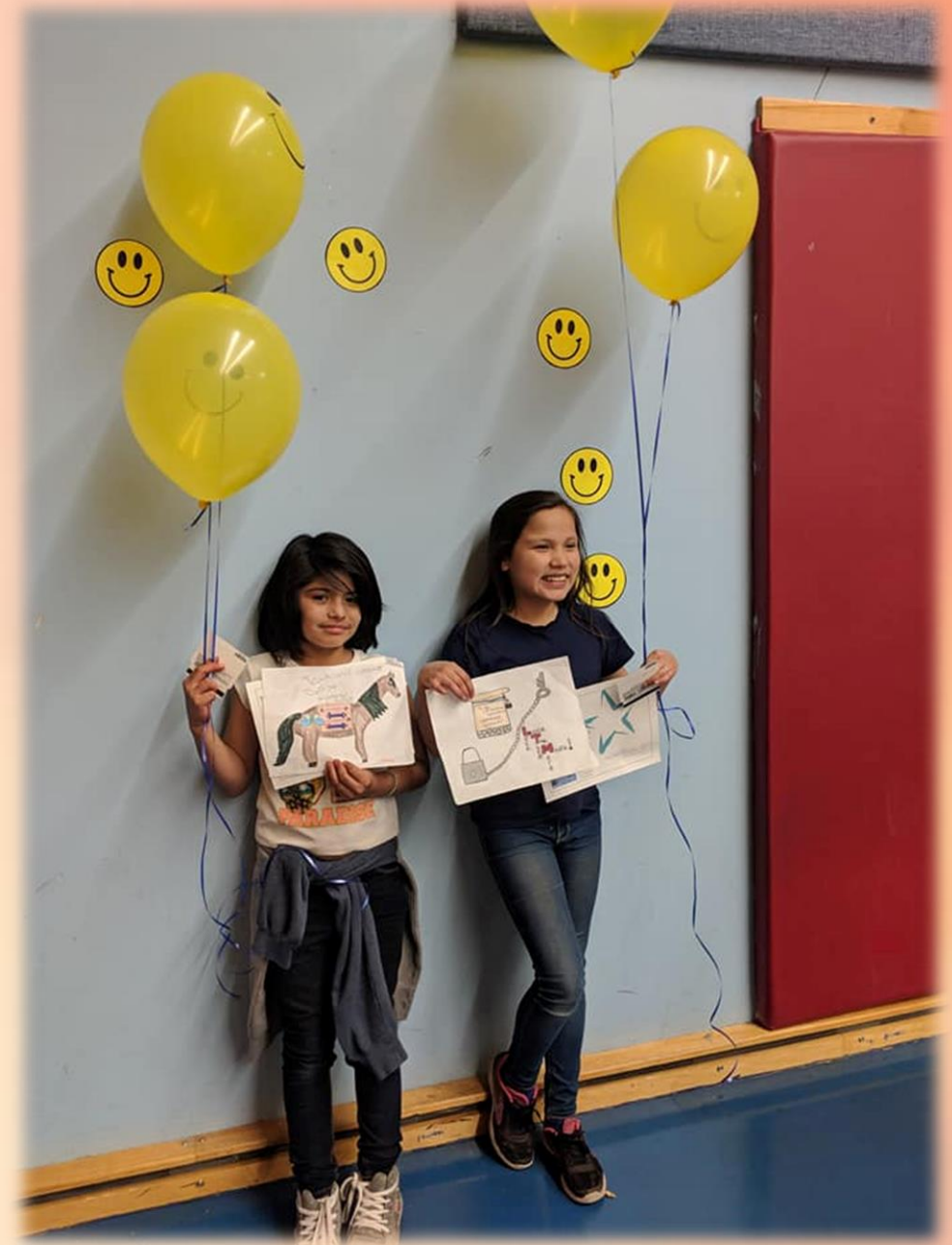
# Sticker Shock Campaign

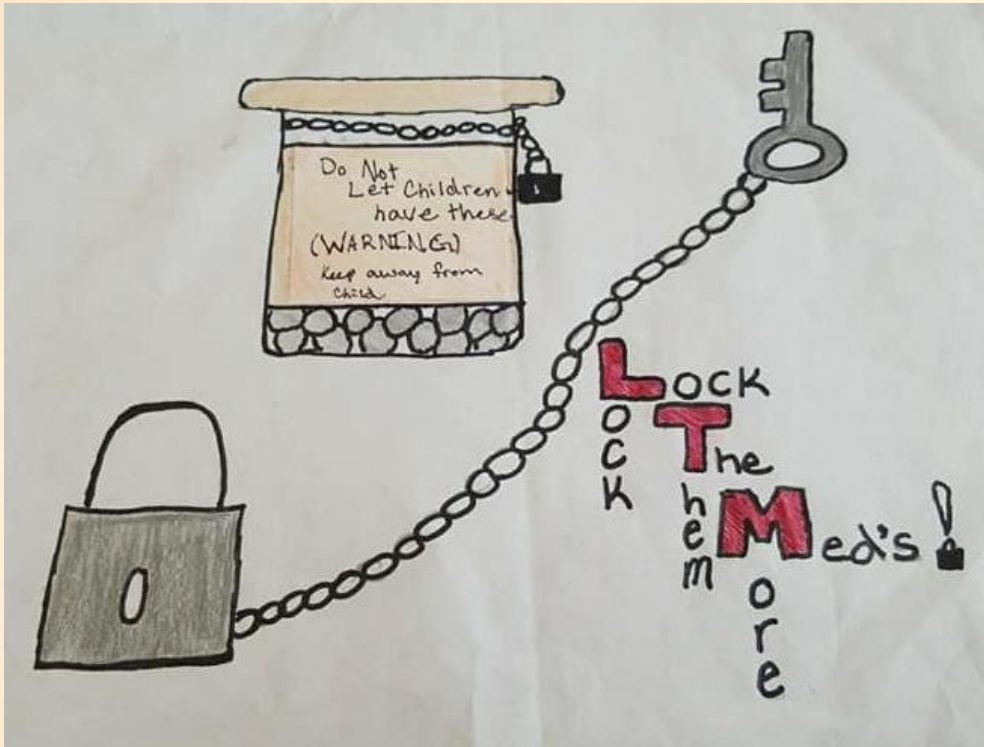
