



Nez Perce Education Standard: Evaluating Mastery

The 6th grade class were taught the story 'íiwc'iwacya - "Bed-wetter". The hiteemenew'éet – students liked this titwáatit - story. They enjoyed doing the chant from this titwaatit and dancing to it. The hiteemenw'éet received a titwatiyaw'áat "Storyteller" award and a \$5 Dutch Brother's or Walmart card from the Nez Perce Language Program for telling the story to a relative. The relative reported to the sepehitemenew'éet - teachers Mrs. Hamilton, Mrs. Kinnick, and Angel Sobotta that their miyá'c - child told the titwáatit to them.

The titwáatit have many ta'c téecukwe - good lessons and teach about our niimíipuum wéetes - People's land. The hiteemenew'éet - students also learn nimipuutímt - the People's language as well. The tiwáatit are told every week. On occasion the hiteemenw'éet act out the titwáatit. Ta'sníx pekúuye titwatiyaw'áat - You did very good Storytellers.
