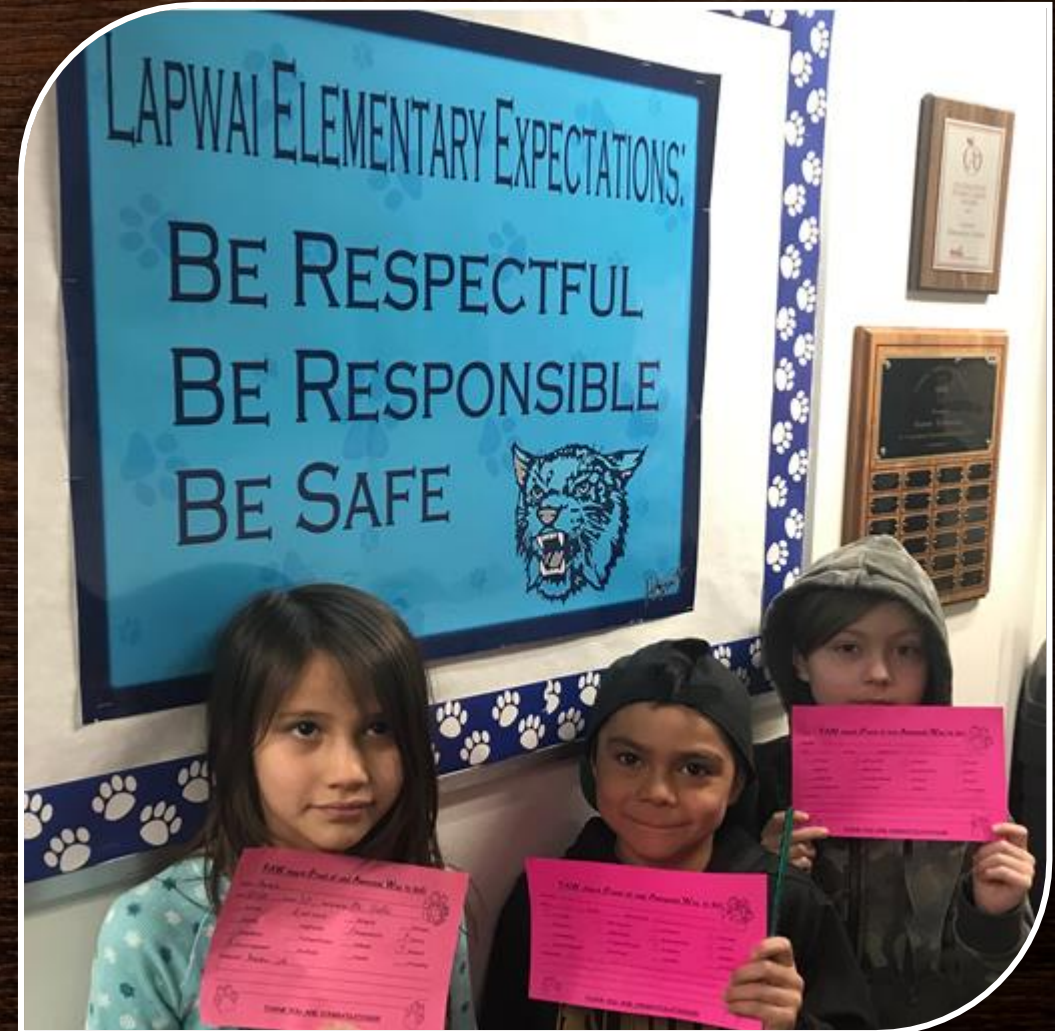

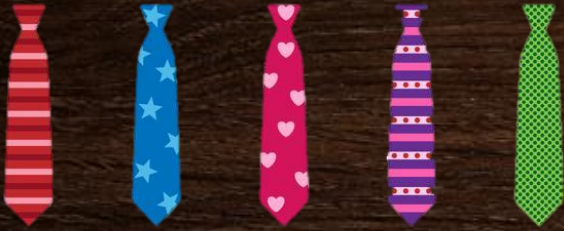
2nd Grade Scientists
