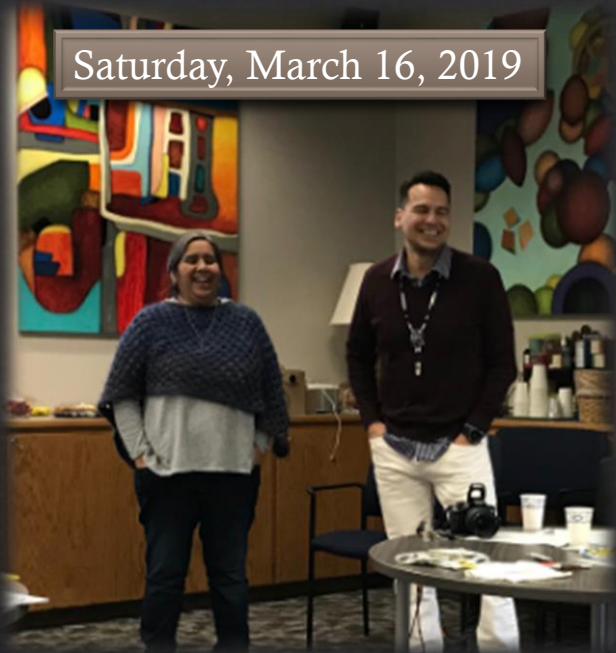

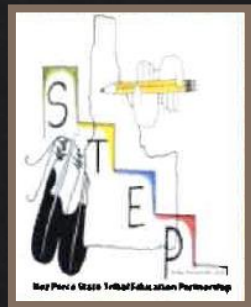

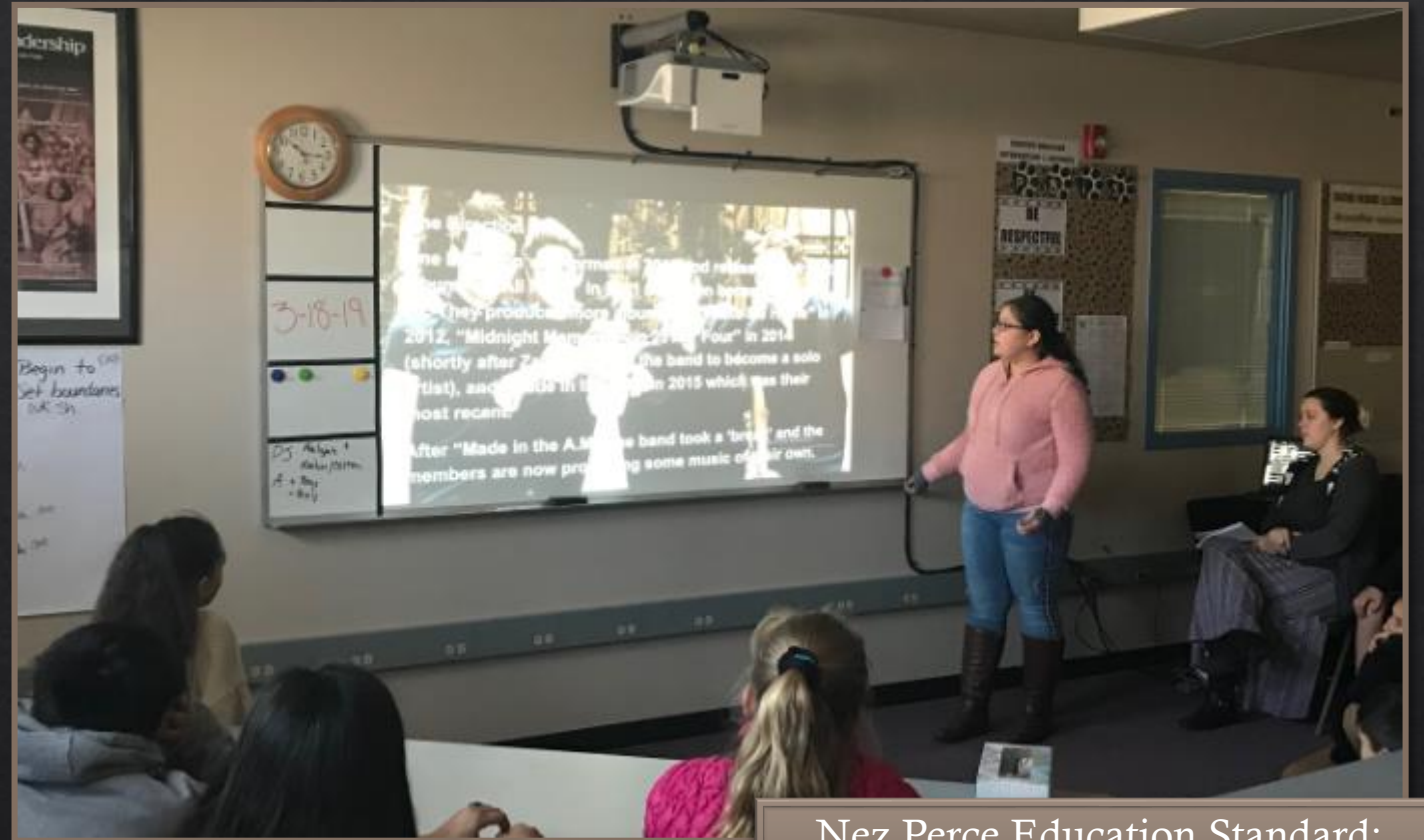

# Pinwheel Parade

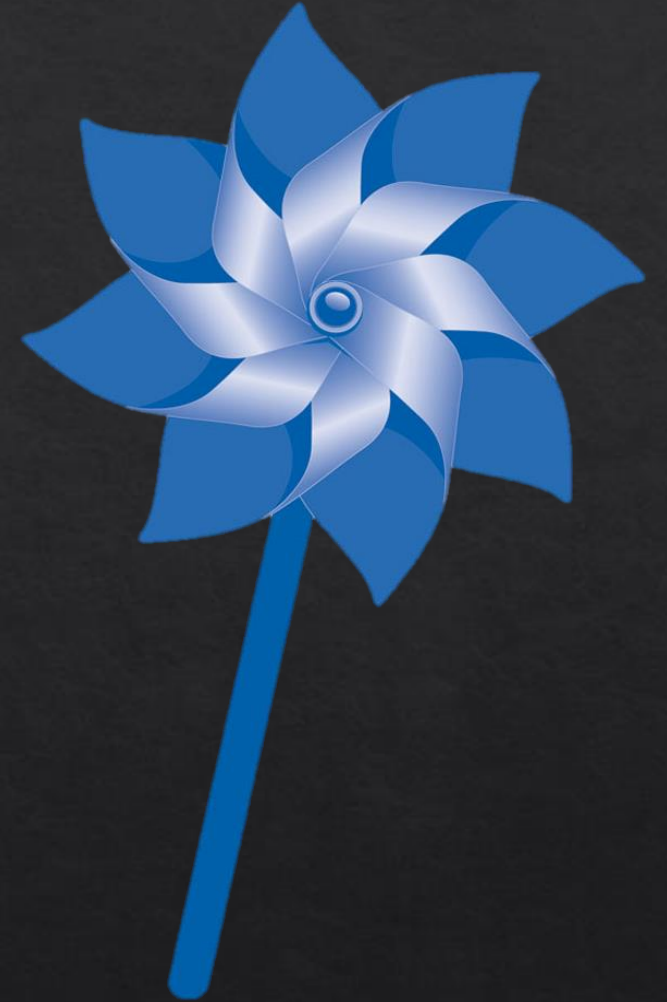
## April 26th, 2019
