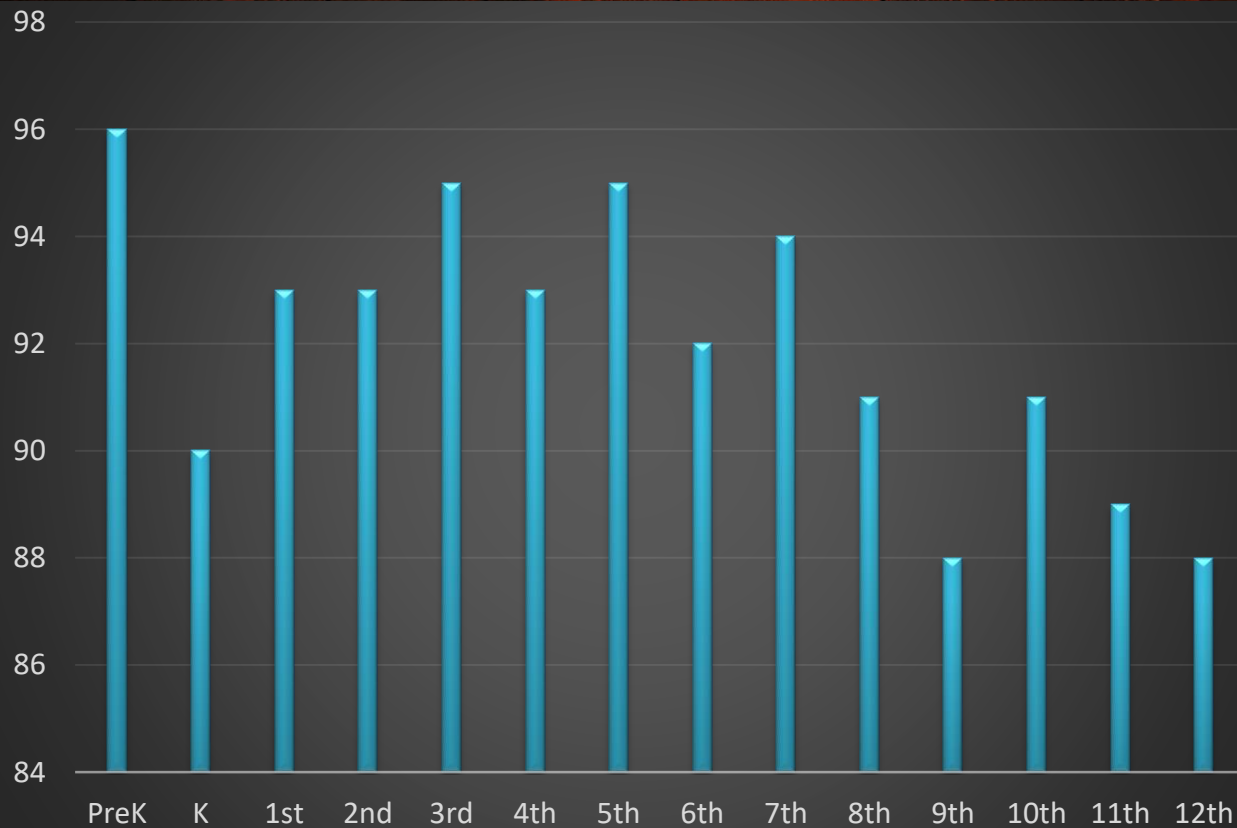

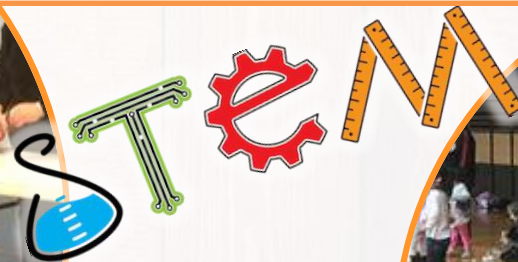

Lapwai Elementary Afterschool Program



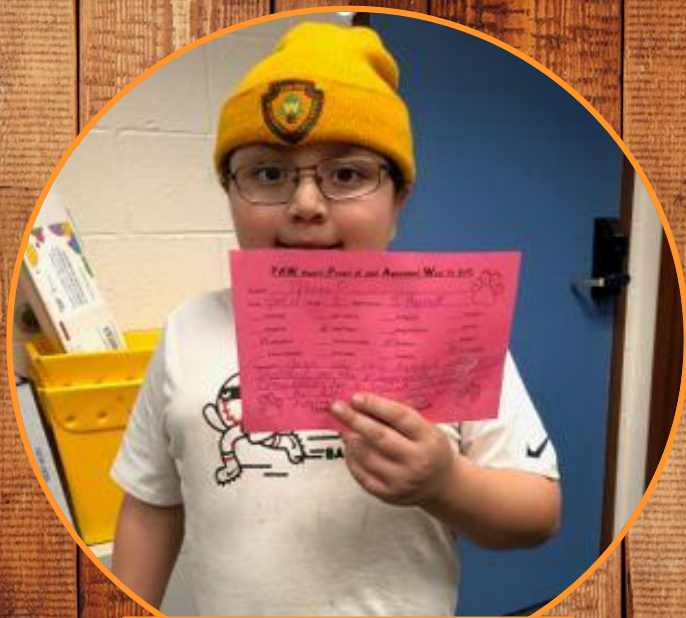

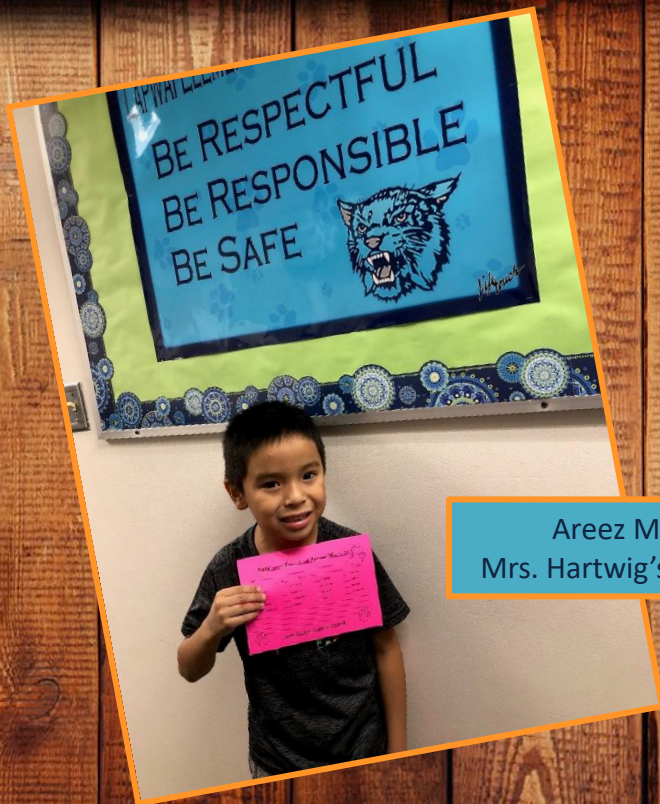

Absent in Kindergarten & 1st
Grade Are Unable to Read
On-Level by 3rd Grade

Grades 9-12: When a student misses twelve (12) days in any given period in a semester, the student will be withdrawn and lose credit for each class with 12 or more absences.

Students Who Cannot Read
On-Level in 3rd Grade Are

4X

More Likely to Drop Out
Than Kids Who Can

By 6th Grade, chronic absences
become a leading indicator that
a student will drop out of high school
