Mr. Nellesen recruited high school students to visit 6th graders about preparing for 7th grade and selecting classes.





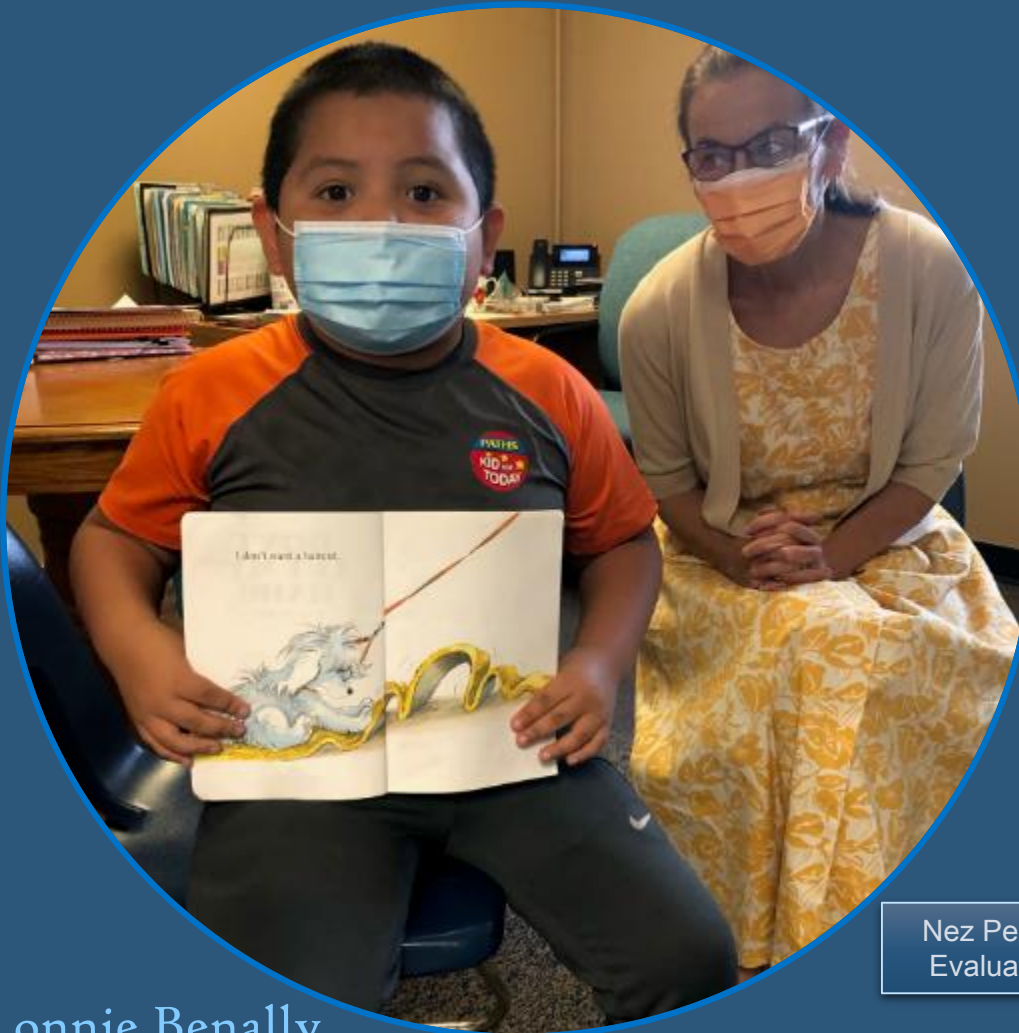

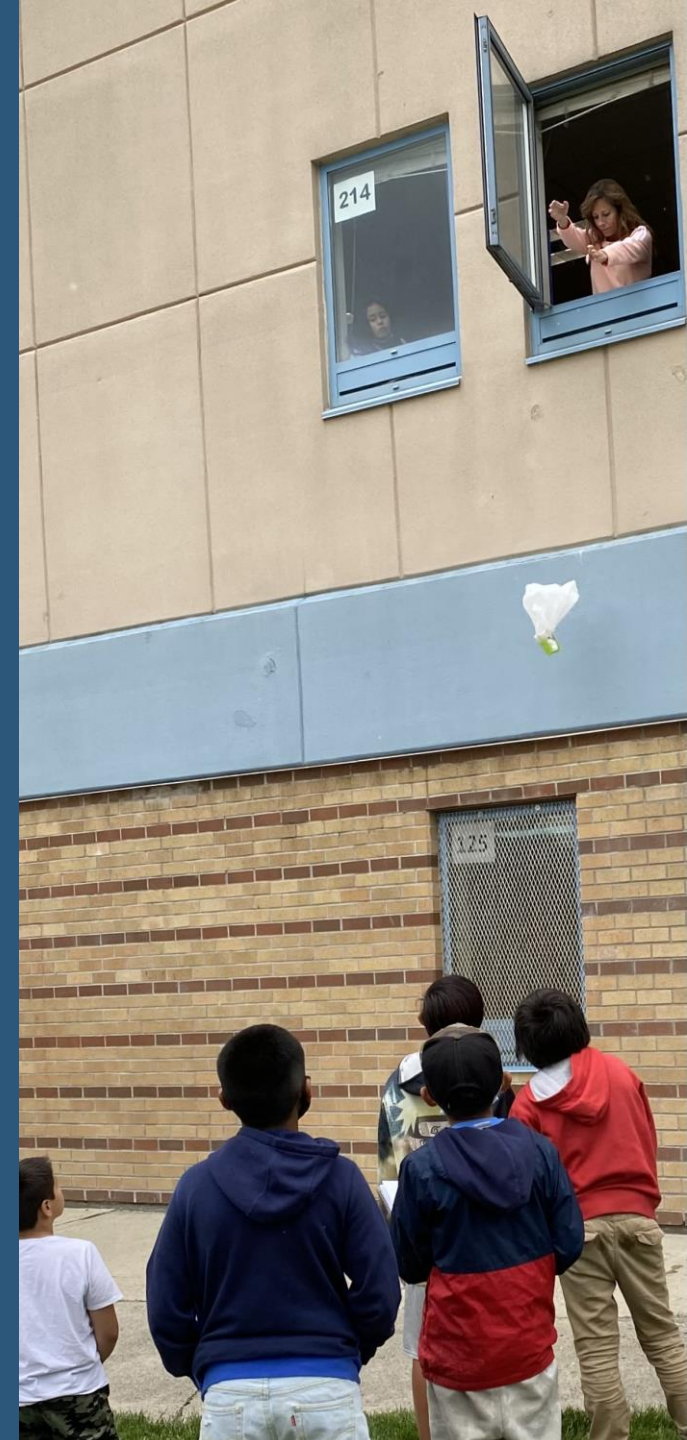




4th Grade Engineers

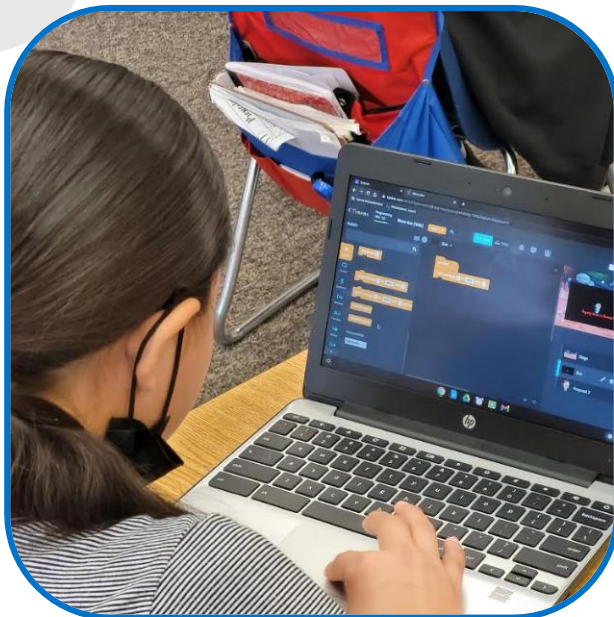
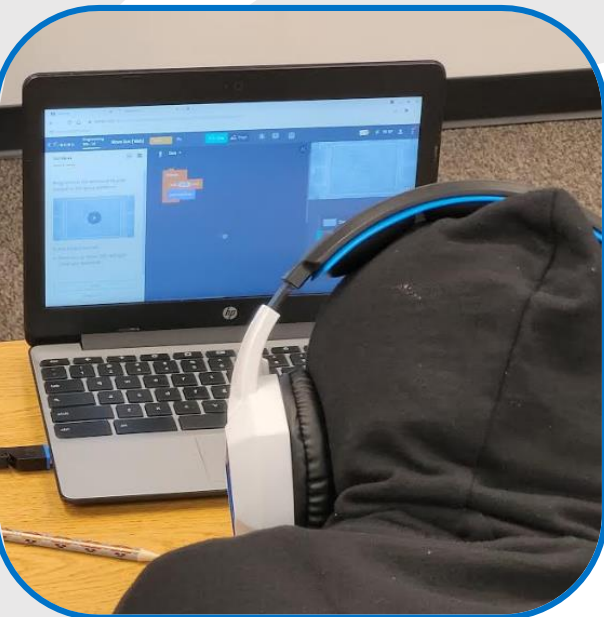

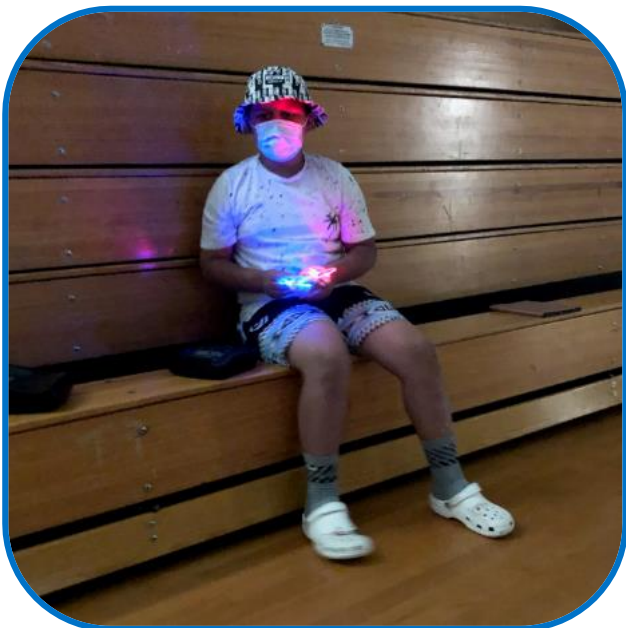
RANDOM ACTS OF KINDNESS AWARD

NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS TIME TO REAPPLY

- Out-of-district open enrollment is a program that spans one school year at a time. Parents/guardians must reapply each spring for the following school year.
- Open Enrollment Applications are available at the Lapwai School District Office. **New and returning** students who do not reside within the Lapwai School District were encouraged to apply prior to **June 4th**.
- Students must obey all policies and regulations of the Lapwai Schools as a condition for continued enrollment.
- Exclusive of school-scheduled activities, non-resident students must maintain a minimum of 88% of the classroom-scheduled time per semester as a condition for continued enrollment.
