Interpersonal Relationships

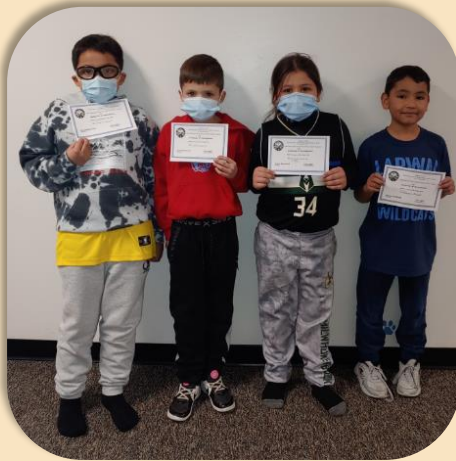

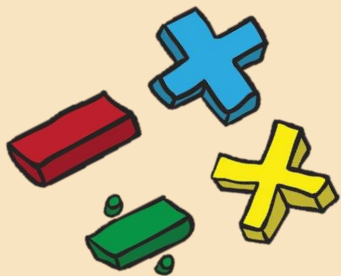


Math at Home

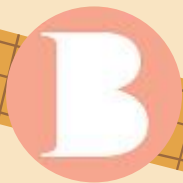
