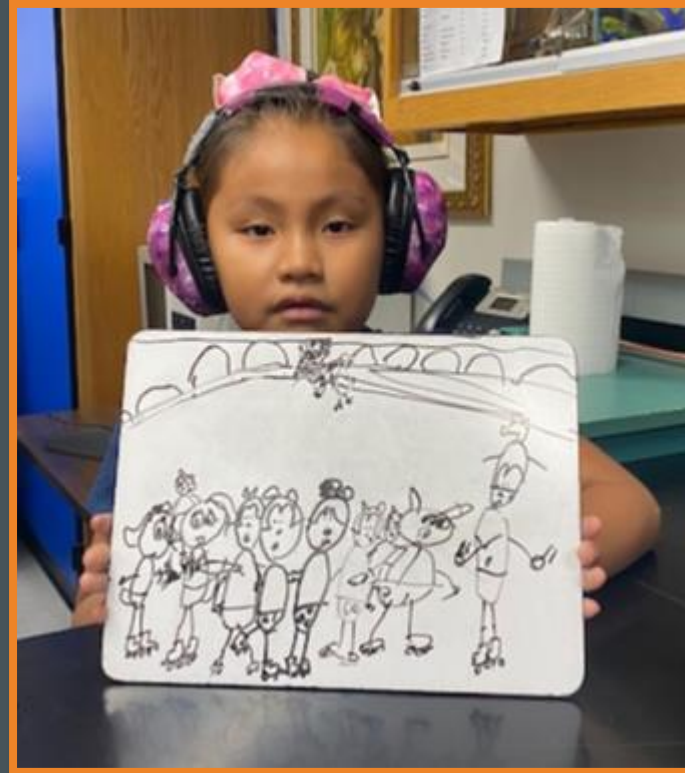
- Native American Studies

- Plains and Plateau Culture

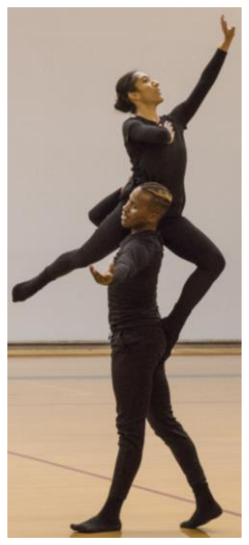
The Research and Native Issues students are interviewing elders for a paper and preparing PowerPoint presentations.

Lapwai Elementary School dancers impressed the professional dancers at the end of the performance.



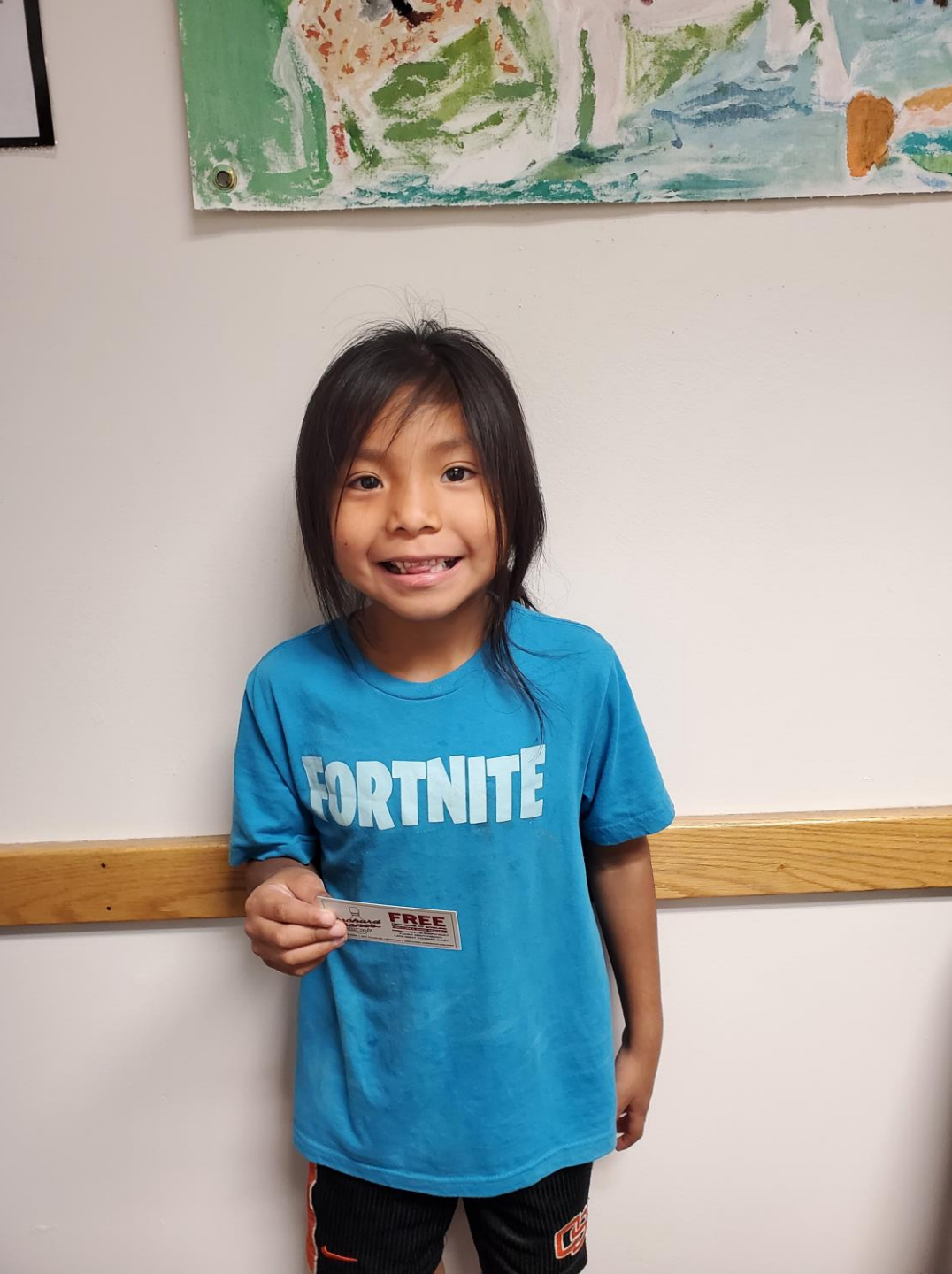
