

Average Daily Attendance




Did You Know? Missing just 2 days per month means a child misses 13 % of the school year!

Every Student Every Day

Students who are chronically absent in preschool, kindergarten, and first grade are much less likely to read at grade level by third grade—which would make them

4 times

more likely to drop out of high school than proficient readers.

Being present 90% of the school year sounds great until you count the 17 days of lost learning, leaving a student over three weeks behind their peers in instruction!

A student who is chronically absent any year between grades 8 and 12 is more than

7 times

more likely to drop out.






