Nimiipuu Health, in partnership with the United States National Guard as part of the Innovative Readiness Training (IRT), will be providing no-cost medical services to our communities

May 16-19 from 8am-5pm

Lapwai Elementary Gym in coordination with NMPH staff & Lapwai Schools - Health checks - well-child exams - dental - sports physicals - eye exams - diabetic/asthma/cardiovascular exams and more

Elementary & Middle/High School youth will be prioritized for dental exams, sealants, & simple restorative work - during school hours for youth with completed permission forms

All other services will be open to any age
