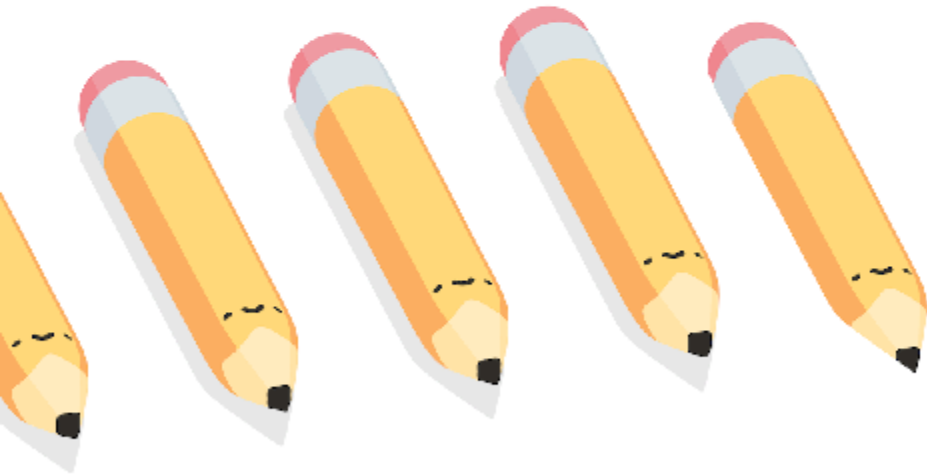


Lapwai Middle-High School Native Culture & Language Team

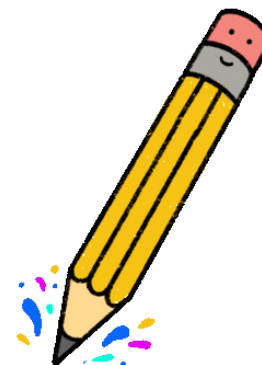

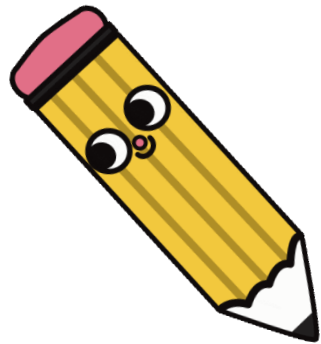

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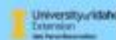
Hot Spring Day Trip w/Kaya
