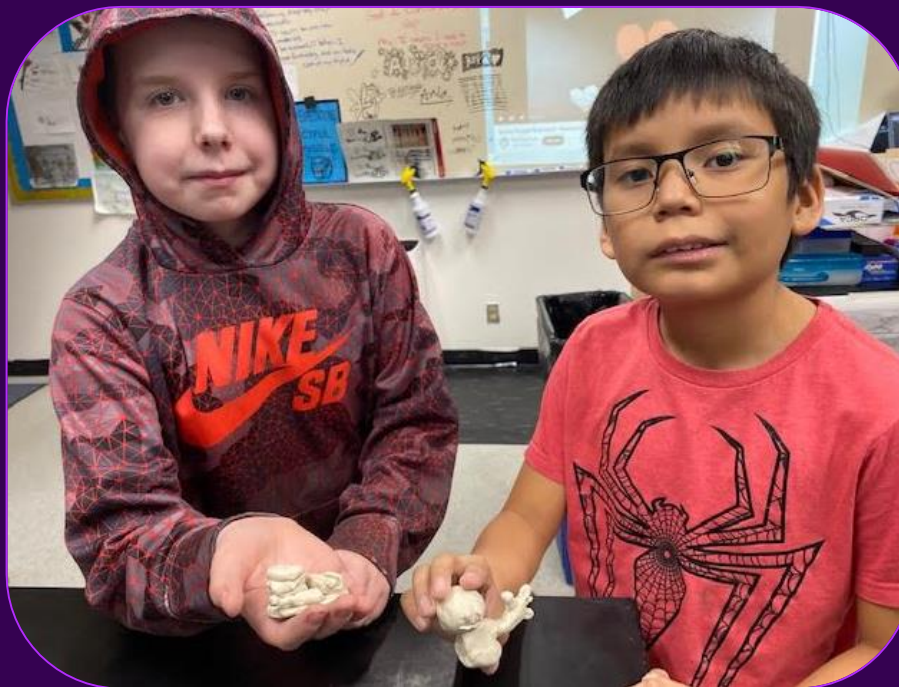

# Lapwai Middle-High School

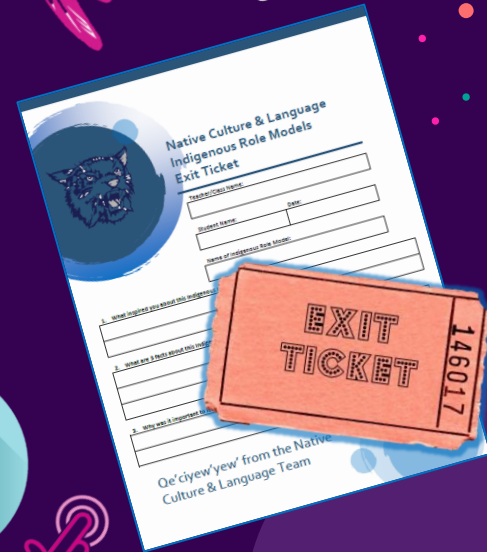
