Localized Pathways for Regional Workforce and Educational Opportunities



CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT MEDICAL PATHWAY

PATHWAY OVERVIEW: The IDLA CNA program serves as the core credential, with Medical Terminology, Fundamentals of Health Professions, Human Biology, Psychology, and Sociology stacked around it. Students build workforce readiness through CNA certification while earning transferable college credit toward nursing or health degrees.

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BUSINESS MANAGEMENT PATHWAY

PATHWAY OVERVIEW: Prepares students for careers in business, entrepreneurship, management, finance, marketing, accounting, and leadership. Students will gain real-world business skills, earn college credit, and develop the knowledge needed to succeed in both the workforce and postsecondary education. This pathway combines Career Technical Education (CTE), dual credit opportunities, workforce readiness training, and college preparation to ensure students graduate ready for their next step.

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AGRICULTURAL FABRICATIONS PATHWAY

PATHWAY OVERVIEW: Designed for students interested in agriculture, welding, fabrication, construction, mechanics, natural resources, and skilled trades. Through hands-on learning, leadership development, industry experiences, and workplace training, students graduate prepared for employment, apprenticeships, technical schools, or college programs related to agriculture and industrial technology. This pathway combines Career Technical Education (CTE), leadership development, environmental science, welding, fabrication, and real-world internship experiences to prepare students for success in Idaho's growing agricultural and trades industries.

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COLLEGE READINESS PATHWAY

PATHWAY OVERVIEW: Designed for students who plan to attend a college, university, or advanced workforce training program after high school. Through rigorous coursework, dual credit opportunities, and advanced academic experiences, students can graduate from Lapwai High School prepared to succeed in higher education.
