- Use positive strategies to keep students safe, focused, and ready to learn.
- Work one-on-one and in small groups to help students develop skills for school and life.
- Assist with daily living skills when needed, such as toilet training and diapering.
- Provide physical support for students, including lifting small children who are non-ambulatory.
- Maintain confidentiality at all times, respecting the privacy of students and families.
- Learn about and support Special Education services in a diverse population of students.
- Work as part of a team that includes special education teachers, speech and language therapists, occupational therapists, physical therapists, school psychologists, and Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs).

- A good communicator who works well with teachers, therapists, staff, and families.
- Willing to be trained in Safety Care, which includes strategies for preventing and responding to challenging behaviors. Safety Care also provides physical management training to ensure the safety of both staff and students.
